## ROCKS AND RUINS

Hampi is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located in Ballari district of Karnataka. This boulder strewn fantasy land has challenged time, survived the centuries and lived to tell the tale. Hampi's ruins are spread over 4187 hectares (41 sq km) and includes forts, royal and sacred complexes, temples, shrines, pillared halls, mandapas and memorial structures among others.

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Get transported to a world where sedate plains suddenly rise to dizzying mist covered hilly heights, and then plunge with careless abandon in a white-watered free fall to become languid rivers that flow past dense jungles teeming with wildlife.







## CALL OF THE WILD

Once the private hunting reserve of the Maharaja of Mysore, Bandipur National Park is flanked by Karnataka's Rajiv Gandhi National Park (Nagarahole) to its northwest, Tamil Nadu's Mudumalai Wildlife Sanctuary to its south, and Kerala's Wayanad Wildlife Sanctuary to its southwest. Together, these constitute the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve. The park spanning an area of 872.24 square kilometers is now a protected zone for over 100 species of mammals, including tiger, elephant, leopard, gaur and chital among others. It's also home to an impressive 200 species of birds.

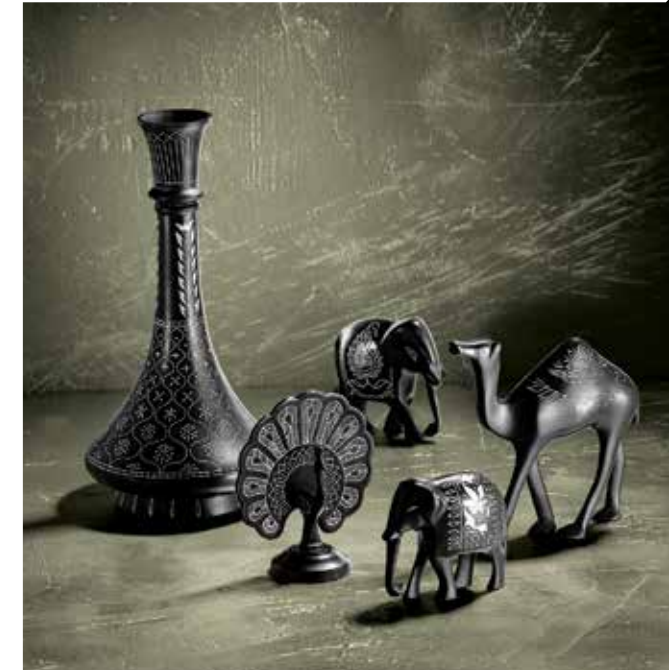


## YAKSHAGANA

The “celestial song” or ‘Yakshagana’ is the most enchanting amalgamation of dance, music and literature. ## CHANNAPATNA LACQUERWARE

Channapatna became the “toy town of Karnataka” nearly 200 years ago. Impressed by the craft of a lacquered-wood toy from Persia, the ruler of Mysuru is said to have brought artisans from Persia to train local artists in the craft. The rest they say is history. ## LALBAGH GARDENS

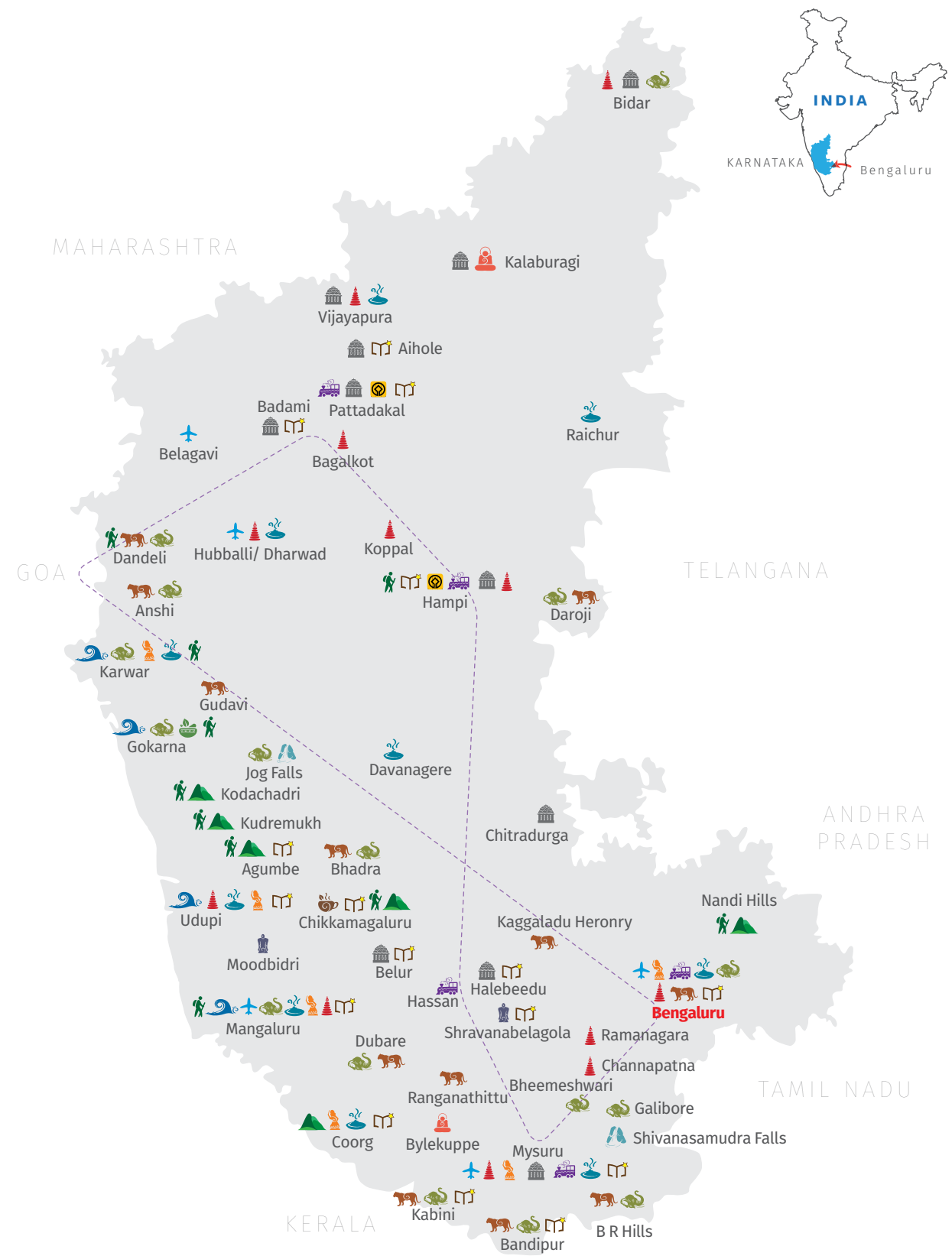

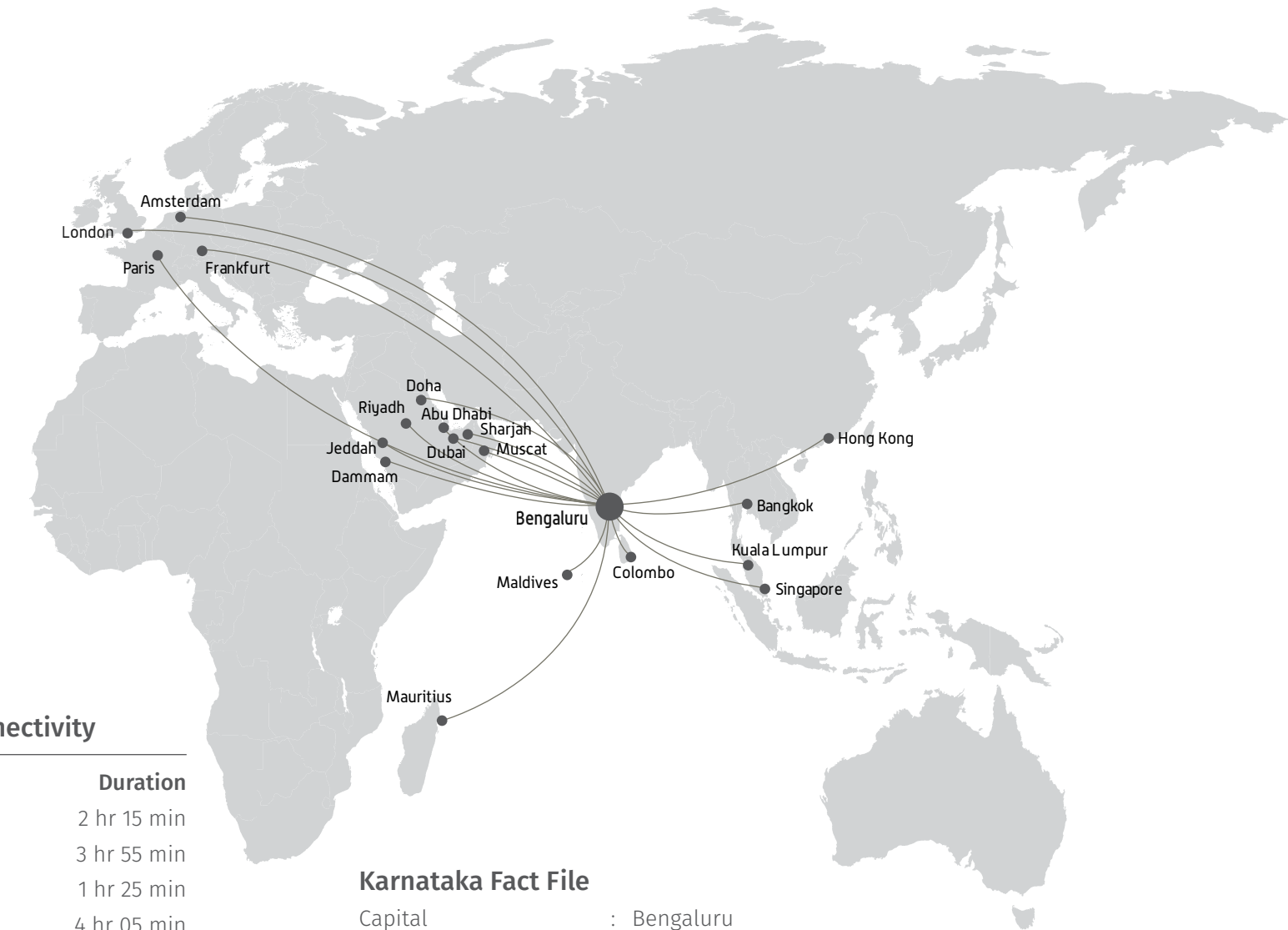
